Suffering from Allergies

An allergy is your body's way of saying "I don't like it" to a substance to which you are hypersensitive, called an allergen. Allergens cause your body's immune system to produce antibodies to protect you. The antibodies, in turn, cause the release of inflammatory chemicals such as histamines, resulting in allergy symptoms. Our environment, at home or outdoors, can be a source of allergens. Dust, mold, and pollen are some of the common culprits.



Common Allergy Symptoms Includes

- puffy, itchy and watery eyes
- headache
- nasal drainage
- rash

- sneezing
- nasal congestion
- hives
- scratchy throat

Allergy Tests Available:

- RAST blood test tells which antibody or antibodies your body is producing and therefore which allergens are likely to cause a reaction.
- Skin prick/puncture on the arms or back. These tests are done to identify allergies to pollen, mold, pet dander, dust mites, and foods.

Treatment:

There are several forms of treatment available:

- weekly allergy injections
- sublingual allergy drops (done at home)
- allergy medication
